WHAT IS THE JOB LIKE?

By teaching communities how to feed themselves through a self-sustainable economy, where animals such as poultry, fish, or ducks are raised in the center, and their waste serves as ecological fertilizer for vegetables grown on the surrounding levels, contributing to educating young people about the growing importance of agriculture for their future and that of the planet.



LOCATION

The Project has already been implemented in countries such as Angola, Guinea-Bissau, and Guatemala, but it was conceived in the municipality of Lindale, Texas. The good news is that we have a complete structure installed at our base in Lindale, Texas, serving as a practical example of this very purposeful project.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Cultural, sociological, and natural aspects that are integrated into the Seed Project:

The mandala system, circular planting, subsistence farming, and fish (fish farming) and bird breeding.

Through Project Seed, you can also earn this opportunity to work in East Texas or anywhere in the world!



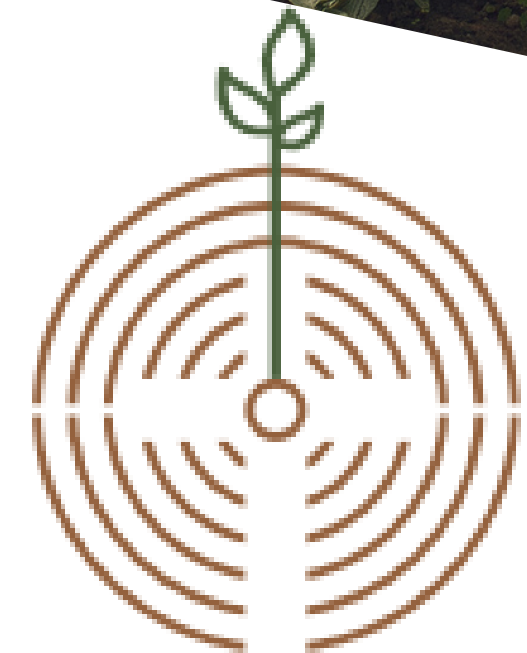


CURRENT SITUATION

We realize that our children and young people are increasingly exposed to a world of distorted values when compared to the light of God's word.

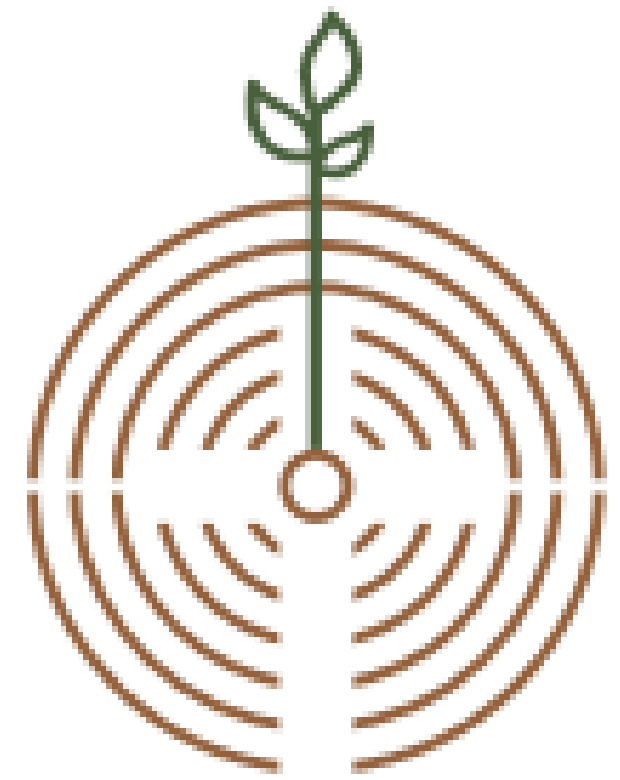
We also observe that young people do not value work in the fields and many are not even familiar with it, due to excessive exposure to technology, losing contact with the land and an important part of their psychological development.

We also conclude that in many families, young people are not encouraged to reach out to others and do not know the love of God manifested through sharing.

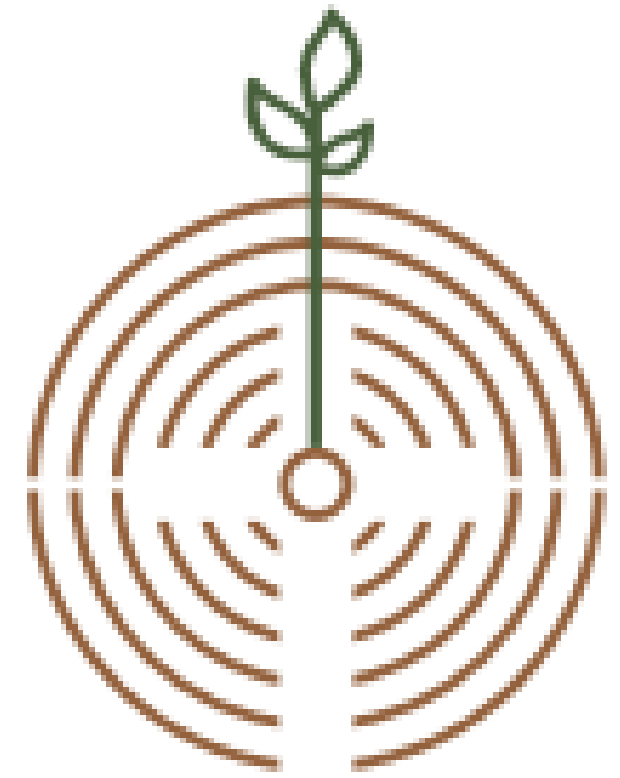


OUR PROPOSAL
